8. Reporting. A dealer licensed under this section shall report the total annual harvest of elvers received by that dealer to the department within 30 days after the end of the elver

18 fishing season. The commissioner shall prescribe how that data and any other information necessary for a meaningful analysis of 20 the elver harvest are reported to the department.'

SUMMARY

This amendment is the majority report and provides that only those who held an elver fishing license in 2006 are eligible to obtain an elver fishing license in subsequent years. It also requires an elver dealer to report the total harvest of elvers received by that dealer annually to the Department of Marine Resources within 30 days of the close of the elver fishing season. This amendment also amends the emergency preamble to better reflect the provisions of the amendment.
