#### **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

This bill includes a General Fund appropriation of \$8,000 in fiscal year 2006-07 for the Employment Security Services program within the Department of Labor for the costs associated with annually calculating the liveable wage for various household sizes. Of this amount, \$3,000 is one-time costs for programming and other set up expenses. The Employment Security Services program will require ongoing General Fund appropriations of \$5,000 per year beginning in fiscal year 2006-07 for the costs associated with data collection and analysis and for preparing the required report.
