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Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §5219-S, as amended by PL 2003, c. 20, Pt.
GG, §1, is further amended to read:

#### \$5219-S. Earned income credit

A taxpayer is allowed a <u>refundable</u> credit against the taxes otherwise due under this Part equal to 5% 30% of the federal earned income credit for the same taxable year, except—that—for tax—years—beginning—in—2003,—2004—and—2005,—the—applicable percentage—is—4.92%—instead—of—5%. The—credit—may—not—reduce—the state—income—tax—to—less—than—mero—

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### 16 SUMMARY

This bill is a recommendation of the Study Commission Regarding Liveable Wages. The bill expands the Maine earned income tax credit by increasing it to 30% of the federal credit and by making it refundable.
