An Act To Amend the Harness Racing Laws Regarding Distributions from the Fund to Supplement Harness Racing Purses

(EMERGENCY)

Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts of the Legislature do not 2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

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Whereas, an inequity exists with regard to the timing of 6 disbursements of funds to supplement harness racing purses; and

Whereas, the inequity will have a negative impact on harness 8 racing purses provided at certain agricultural fairs in the 2006 racing season; and 10

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts 12 create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 14 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 16 safety; now, therefore,

18 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 8 MRSA §298, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 2003, c. 687, Pt. A, §3 and affected by Pt. B, §11, is amended to read:

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Distribution. On May-30th, -- September -30th April 30th, 2. July 30th, October 30th and January 30th of each year, all 24 amounts credited to the fund established by this section as of 26 the last day of the preceding month and not distributed before that day must be distributed to each commercial track, as defined in section 275-A, subsection 1, and to each agricultural fair 28 association that during the preceding trimester has conducted live racing with pari-mutuel wagering on dates assigned by the 30 commissioner pursuant to Title 7, section 65, and to each licensed racetrack that conducted an extended meet, referred to 32 in this subsection as a "licensed racetrack," if the licensed race track conducted an extended meet during calendar year 2005, 34 with each commercial track and---each_ agricultural fair association and licensed racetrack receiving an amount of money 36 determined by multiplying the amount of money available for distribution times a fraction, the numerator of which is the 38 total number of live race dashes conducted by the commercial 40 track er, agricultural fair association or licensed racetrack during the preceding time period and the denominator of which is the total number of race dashes conducted by all commercial 42 associations and licensed tracks and, agricultural fair racetracks during that time period. The payment in January must 44 be adjusted so that for the prior 3-time-periods year each commercial track er, agricultural fair association or licensed 46 racetrack entitled to a distribution receives that fraction portion of the total money distributed over the full year from 48 the fund established by this section, -- the -- amount that is total amount of money determined by multiplying the so 50 distributed by a fraction, the numerator of which is the

number of live race dashes conducted by the commercial track ΘF_{L} 2 agricultural fair association or licensed racetrack during the calendar year that qualify for a distribution and the denominator 4 of which is the total number of race dashes conducted during that calendar year by-all-such-fairs that qualify for a distribution. For purposes of the subsection a race dash qualifies for a 6 distribution if the race dash was conducted by a commercial 8 track, agricultural fair association or licensed racetrack on dates assigned by the commissioner pursuant to Title 7, section 10 65 and-by-all-commercial-tracks-during-that-calendar-year or by an extended meet conducted by such a commercial track, 12 agricultural fair association or licensed racetrack, but only to the extent that dashes conducted by such an extended meet do not exceed the number of dashes that commercial track, agricultural 14 fair association or licensed racetrack conducted in calendar year 16 The funds distributed pursuant to this section must be 2005. used to supplement harness racing purses. 18 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the 20 preamble, this Act takes effect when approved. 22 SUMMARY 24 This bill makes the following changes to the laws concerning 26 racing.

- 28 1. It authorizes quarterly payments from the Fund to Supplement Harness Racing Purses rather than trimester payments.
- 2. It bases the first 3 quarterly payments on the number of 32 race dashes assigned to a racetrack in proportion to the total number of dashes awarded to all racetracks, rather than the 34 number of actual dashes raced in that quarter.
- 36 3. It bases the 4th quarterly payment on the number of actual dashes raced by a racetrack in proportion to the total
 38 actual dashes conducted by all racetracks.
- 40 4. It includes in the disbursement of funds those licensed racetracks that conducted an extended meet in 2005.
