management organizations of the State an annual assessment of
each organization's degree of emergency management capability and
any other information pertinent to ensuring the public's welfare
and safety within the local organization's jurisdiction; and has
additional authority, duties and responsibilities as may be
prescribed by the commissioner.'

SUMMARY

This amendment strikes the language that modifies the required qualifications of the Director of the Maine Emergency 12 Management Agency within the Department of Defense, Veterans and 14 Emergency Management to require education, training or experience in managing emergencies or in the emergency management 16 profession. The amendment also strikes the language that requires that the Director of the Maine Emergency Agency be appointed by the Governor, serve at the pleasure of the Governor, 18 be for responsible for notifying the Governor and Commissioner of 20 Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management of all emergencies and represent the Governor on all matters pertaining to the comprehensive emergency management program and the disaster and 22 emergency response of the State.
