HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 789, L.D. 2044, Bill, "An Act To Enhance the Protection of Maine Families from Terrorism and Natural Disasters"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 11.

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 21 and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 21. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

Study Commissions - Funding 0444

Initiative: Allocates funds necessary to change one previously authorized meeting of the Task Force to Study Maine's Homeland Security Needs to an off-site public hearing. The Maine Emergency Management Agency shall transfer these funds to the Legislature at the beginning of fiscal year 2006-07 to support the additional costs of the task force.



Legislative Study

This amendment decreases the cost of the study by not authorizing two additional meetings. It reduces the bill's Other Special Revenue Funds allocation to the Legislature to \$1,000 in fiscal year 2006-07 for offsite public hearing costs of one already authorized meeting of the Task Force to Study Maine's Homeland Security Needs. The amendment also authorizes a one-time Other Special Revenue Funds transfer of \$1,000 in fiscal year 2006-07 from the Maine Emergency Management Agency within the Department of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management to the Legislature to cover these additional costs.
