HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1449, L.D. 2055, Bill, "An Act To Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine"

Amend the amendment by adding after Part E the following:

PART F


Sec. F-1. 32 MRSA §14354, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 275, §1, is amended by adding after the first paragraph a new paragraph to read:

This section does not preclude a person from providing athletic training to an athlete as long as the person does not use the title "athletic trainer" alone or in connection with other words or the initials "AT" alone or in connection with other initials.'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that a person may provide athletic training to an athlete as long as the person does not use the title "athletic trainer" alone or in connection with other words or the initials "AT" alone or in connection with other initials.
