28	supplement under subsection 1 without calling for a special meeting of the local legislative body.
30	Sec. F-2. 20-A MRSA §15689, sub-§7, ¶D is enacted to read:
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34	D. For fiscal year 2006-07 only, a school administrative unit may expend any funds received through the adjustment under this section without calling for a special meeting of
36	the local legislative body.'
38	Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read
40	consecutively.
42	SUMMARY
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46	This amendment authorizes school administrative units to expend state funds provided for new minimum teacher salaries and

for salary supplements for national board-certified teachers without calling for a special meeting of the local legislative body. These provisions apply to fiscal year 2006-07 only.
