 of age. Except as provided in subsection 6, a person 10 14 years of age or older but under 16 19 years of age may not operate an ATV unless that person has successfully completed a training course approved by the department pursuant to section 13152 and is-aecompanied-by-an-adult.

- This amendment raises the age limit for a person who must 50 take an ATV safety course before operating an ATV from 16 to 19

years of age and requires a person under 14 years of age to be accompanied by an adult even after the completion of the training course.

It also lowers the age at which a person may cross a public way with an ATV from 16 to 14 years of age to make this provision consistent with snownobile laws.
