1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2395, sub-§9** is enacted to read:

3 **9. Equipment used for timber harvesting; exemption.** A vehicle used in  
4 Aroostook County or Penobscot County for the trucking of equipment used in timber  
5 harvesting operations is exempt from the provisions of this section during nighttime.

6 **SUMMARY**

7 This bill exempts vehicles used in Aroostook County or Penobscot County for the  
8 trucking of equipment used in timber harvesting operations during nighttime from  
9 restrictions placed on roads concerning weight, speed, operation and equipment.
