An Act To Issue Certificates of Title for Single-unit Mobile Homes

Reported by Representative SIMPSON of Auburn for the Secretary of State pursuant to Resolve 2005, chapter 103.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §101, sub-§32-B is enacted to read:

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32-B. Manufactured housing. "Manufactured housing" means a structural unit or units designed to be used as a dwelling or dwellings and constructed in a manufacturing facility and then transported by the use of its own chassis or placement on an independent chassis to a building site. "Manufactured housing" includes any type of building that is constructed at a manufacturing facility and then transported to a building site where it is used for housing and that may be purchased, sold, offered for sale or brokered by a licensee in the interim. Three types of manufactured housing are included. They are:

16 Units constructed after June 15, 1976 that the manufacturer certifies are constructed in compliance with the code adopted by the United States Department of Housing 18 and Urban Development and that are structures, transportable 20 in one or more sections that, in the traveling mode, are & body feet or more in width and 40 body feet or more in 22 length or, when erected on site, are 320 or more square feet and are built on a permanent chassis and designed to be used as dwellings, with or without permanent foundations, when 24 connected to the required utilities, including the plumbing, heating, air-conditioning and electrical systems within the 26 units; except that "manufactured housing" includes any structure that meets all the requirements of this paragraph 28 except the size requirements and with respect to which the manufacturer voluntarily files a certification required by 30 the Secretary of the United States Department of Housing and 32 Urban Development and complies with the standards established under the National Manufactured Housing

States Code, Section 5401 et seq.;

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B. State-certified modular homes, which are those units that the manufacturer certifies are constructed in compliance with the State's laws and rules governing manufactured housing, meaning structures, transportable in one or more sections, that are not constructed on a permanent chassis and are designed to be used as dwellings on foundations when connected to required utilities, including the plumbing, heating, air-conditioning or electrical systems within the units; and

2 SUMMARY

This bill makes the following changes to the laws governing motor vehicles and certificates of title. 1. It enacts a definition of "manufactured housing" similar to the one in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 10, section 9002, subsection 7. 10 It changes the definition of "mobile home" to make it consistent with the definition of "manufactured housing." 12 14 3. It requires the Secretary of State to issue certificates of title for certain single-unit manufactured housing. 16 It makes clear that certain manufactured housing is 18 exempt from the certificate of title laws. 5. It states who is responsible for filing a certificate of 20 title application with the Secretary of State. 22 6. It exempts certificates of title issued for manufactured 24 housing from the salvage laws. 26 7. It makes clear that the Secretary of State cannot assume a lien is released after 66 months if the certificate of title is issued for manufactured housing. 28 8. It provides an effective date of January 1, 2007.
