HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1485, L.D. 2093, Bill, "An Act To Strengthen the Collection of the Tax on Tobacco Products"

Amend the bill in section 11 in §4404-A by striking out all of subsection 3 (page 5, lines 22 to 26 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'3. Exception for personal use. A person who is not a licensed distributor may:

A. Transport tobacco products other than cigars into this State and transport those tobacco products from place to place within this State for personal use in a quantity not greater than one pound; or

B. Import or transport cigars into this State and transport those cigars from place to place within this State for personal use.'

This amendment provides that a person does not need a license to import or transport cigars for personal use in any quantity into the State.
