
HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 1485, L.D. 2093, Bill, "An Act To Strengthen the Collection of the Tax on Tobacco Products"

Amend the bill in section 11 in §4404-A in subsection 4 in the 2nd line (page 5, line 29 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "50" and inserting in its place the following: '125'

Further amend the bill in section 11 in §4404-C in subsection 2 in paragraph C in the first line (page 7, line 30 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "50" and inserting in its place the following: '125'

SUMMARY

House Amendment "B" (H-1022) changed the number of cigars a person can import or transport for personal use from 50 to 125. This amendment changes references to 50 cigars in 2 places in the bill to conform to the change made by House Amendment "B", which was adopted by both the House and the Senate.
