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HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1494, L.D. 2103, Bill, "An Act To Implement the Recommendations of the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs Regarding Review of the State Board of Education under the State Government Evaluation Act"

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Amend the bill in section 2 by striking out all of paragraph V and inserting in its place the following:

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'V. Study school consolidation administrative unit configuration statewide, develop a school consolidation plan that includes criteria for evaluating opportunities for consolidation and, if desirable, develop a time line for implementation.'

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This amendment removes language relating to the power and duty of the State Board of Education to develop a school administrative unit configuration plan that includes criteria for evaluating opportunities for reconfiguration and, if desirable, develop a time line for implementation.
