1       **Sec. 1. Task force reestablished. Resolved:** That the Task Force on  
2       Citizenship Education, established by Resolve 2003, chapter 143, Part B and referred to  
3       in this resolve as “the task force,” is reestablished for the purposes set forth in that  
4       resolve, and those members serving on the board on December 5, 2005 continue to serve  
5       as members; and be it further

6       **Sec. 2. Reporting deadline extension. Resolved:** That, no later than December  
7       7, 2006, the task force shall submit its final report, including findings, recommendations  
8       and suggested legislation, for presentation to the joint standing committee of the  
9       Legislature having jurisdiction over education matters, the Commissioner of Education  
10      and the Chair of the State Board of Education. The joint standing committee of the  
11      Legislature having jurisdiction over education matters has authority to report out  
12      legislation based on the report to the First Regular Session of the 123rd Legislature.

### SUMMARY

14      This resolve is reported out by the Joint Standing Committee on Education and  
15      Cultural Affairs pursuant to Resolve 2003, chapter 143, Part B, section 2. The resolve  
16      reestablishes the Task Force on Citizenship Education and extends the deadline for its  
17      final report to December 7, 2006. The resolve also provides that the joint standing  
18      committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education matters may report out a  
19      bill to the First Regular Session of the 123rd Legislature to implement the  
20      recommendations of the task force.
