HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 633, "Joint Study Order To Study Sea Urchin Fishery Management"

Amend the order in section 2 in the first sentence by striking out the following: "9 members" and inserting in its place the following: '11 members'

Further amend the order in section 2 by striking out all of paragraphs A and B and inserting in their place the following:

'A. Two members of the Senate, appointed by the President of the Senate, one of whom is a member of the political party that holds the highest number of seats in the Senate and one of whom is a member of the political party that holds the 2nd highest number of seats in the Senate;

B. Two members of the House of Representatives, appointed by the Speaker of the House, one of whom is a member of the political party that holds the highest number of seats in the House of Representatives and one of whom is a member of the political party that holds the 2nd highest number of seats in the House of Representatives;'

SUMMARY

This amendment adds one Senator and one member of the House of Representatives to the Task Force to Study Sea Urchin Fishery Management. As amended, the task force consists of 11 members, 4

2 of whom are Legislators. The amendment specifies that the
3 legislative members include a member from each chamber who is a
4 member of the political party that holds the highest number of
5 seats in that chamber and a member from each chamber who is a
6 member of the political party that holds the 2nd highest number
7 of seats in that chamber.
