2 **Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and  
3 allocations are made.

4 **ADMINISTRATIVE AND FINANCIAL SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF**

5 **Miscellaneous Acts and Resolves**

6 Initiative: Provides funds to reimburse Philip Wolley for attorney's fees, expenses and  
7 interest based on the rate charged by the Maine State Retirement System for the  
8 reinstatement of past service credits.
