1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §11154, sub-§6, ¶A, as amended by PL 2005, c. 12, Pt. III,
3	§10, is further amended to read:
4	A. For a resident:
5	(1) Seven dollars for a one-chance application;
6	(2) Twelve dollars for a 3-chance application. A resident must possess a valid
7	big game hunting license to be eligible to purchase a 3-chance application; and
8	(3) Twenty-two dollars for a 6-chance application. A resident must possess a
9	valid big game hunting license to be eligible to purchase a 6-chance application;
10	or <u>and</u>
11	(4) Thirty-five dollars for a 10-chance application; multiple 10-chance
12	applications may be purchased. A resident must possess a valid big game
13	hunting license to be eligible to purchase a 10-chance application; or
14	SUMMARY
15	This bill creates a 10-chance application for moose hunting permits for residents and
16	allows a resident to purchase multiple 10-chance applications.
