- Sec. 1. Install bicycle lanes on State Route 5. Resolved: That the Department of Transportation, in order to ensure the safety of the students traveling to and from school in Waterboro, shall install bicycle lanes on the portion of State Route 5 from the intersection of State Route 5 and United States Route 202 in East Waterboro to the intersection of Chadbourne Ridge Road in North Waterboro; and be it further
- Sec. 2. Install bicycle lanes on Old Alfred Road. Resolved: That the Department of Transportation shall install bicycle lanes along the full length of Old Alfred Road from the intersection of Old Alfred Road and United States Route 202 to where Old Alfred Road connects to State Route 5.

10 SUMMARY

This resolve directs the Department of Transportation to install bicycle lanes on 2 specific lengths of road in the Town of Waterboro to ensure the safety of students traveling to and from School Administrative District 57 Middle School and Waterboro Elementary School.
