Sec. 1. Maine Turnpike Authority directed to develop tolling strategies.
Resolved: That the Maine Turnpike Authority shall develop, in consultation with the
Department of Transportation, tolling strategies that create incentives for truck through
traffic to use the Maine Turnpike rather than Interstate 295.

SUMMARY

6 This resolve directs the Maine Turnpike Authority, in consultation with the 7 Department of Transportation, to develop tolling strategies designed to divert truck 8 through traffic from Interstate 295 onto the Maine Turnpike.
