## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2	CONCEPT DRAFT SUMMARY
4	This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
5	This bill proposes to provide an income tax credit for any graduate of a 4-year degree
6	program in Maine who starts a business that creates jobs for at least 5 full-time equivalent
7	employees in the first year and 10 full-time equivalent employees in subsequent years.
8	The credit is equal to 1/4 of the cost of a 4-year college degree at any Maine college and
9	can be used annually for up to 4 years in a row.
