1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §468, sub-§8**, as enacted by PL 2001, c. 623, §5, is amended
3 to read:

4 **8. Weight limit.** A specialty license plate may be issued for an automobile or
5 pickup truck that does not exceed 6,000 pounds except that a farm truck that weighs over
6 9,000 pounds may be issued a specialty plate.

7 **SUMMARY**

8 This bill allows a farm truck that weighs more than 9,000 pounds to be issued a
9 specialty license plate.
