SUMMARY

8 This amendment clarifies the system to be developed by the Adjutant General to 9 award gold star medals to relatives living in Maine of members of the United States 10 Armed Forces who are killed in action or die as a result of injuries received in battle since September 11, 2001. The system is to be administered by the Director of the Bureau of 11 12 Maine Veterans' Services within the Department of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management. The amendment provides that up to 3 medals may be awarded. One medal 13 14 would be issued to a surviving spouse and one to the parents or 2 if the parents are 15 divorced. If the service member has no surviving spouse or parents or they live outside of the State, a medal may be awarded to the service member's next of kin. 16
