COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "*B*" to H.P. 64, L.D. 66, Bill, "An Act To Ban Salvia Divinorum"

Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of subsection 10-A (page 1, lines 3 to 5 in L.D.) and inserting the following:

'10-A. Salvia divinorum. "Salvia divinorum" means the herb Salvia divinorum and includes Salvinorin A and Divinorin A.'

SUMMARY

This amendment is one of 2 minority reports of the Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice and Public Safety. The majority report is also "ought to pass as amended" and the second minority report is "ought not to pass." This amendment clarifies the definition of "Salvia divinorum."
