1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 17-A MRS §1252, sub-§10** is enacted to read:

3 10. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 2, the court shall order a period of  
4 imprisonment of at least 25 years to life for a defendant convicted of the offense of  
5 trafficking in methamphetamine when it was proved the defendant manufactured  
6 methamphetamine.

#### SUMMARY

8 This bill requires a prison sentence of 25 years to life for a person convicted of  
9 trafficking in methamphetamine when it was proved the defendant manufactured  
10 methamphetamine.
