1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 17 MRSA §314-A, sub-§4**, as repealed and replaced by PL 1991, c. 426,
3 §4, is amended to read:

4 **4. Term of license; fee may not be charged.** A license issued under this section is
5 valid for a period of one year. ~~The annual license fee for a high-stakes beano license is~~
6 ~~\$50,000, payable in advance in quarterly installments. All license fees must be paid to~~
7 ~~the Treasurer of State to be credited to the General Fund. A fee may not be charged for a~~
8 ~~license issued under this section.~~

9 **SUMMARY**

10 This bill eliminates the annual fee for a high-stakes beano license.
