1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2251, sub-§1**, as amended by PL 1999, c. 61, §1, is further
3 amended to read:

4 **1. Definition.** As used in this section, "reportable accident" means an accident on
5 private property or on a public way, or a place where public traffic may reasonably be
6 anticipated, resulting in bodily injury or death to a person or apparent property damage of
7 \$1,000 or more.

8 **SUMMARY**

9 This bill requires that an accident report be filed for a motor vehicle accident on
10 private property as current law requires for an accident on a public way.
