Resolve, Directing the Department of Health and Human Services To Provide Printed Informational Handouts on Child Care Guidelines

Reference to the Committee on Health and Human Services suggested and ordered printed.

Sec. 1. Printed information on child care guidelines. Resolved: That the Department of Health and Human Services shall provide to any person upon request a printed copy of the child care information that is available on the department's website, including, but not limited to, guidance for selecting a child care provider; and be it further

Sec. 2. Fee. Resolved: That the Department of Health and Human Services shall identify costs associated with providing a printed copy of the child care information under section 1 and charge persons requesting the printed information a fee to cover those costs.

9 SUMMARY

This resolve requires the Department of Health and Human Services to provide a printed copy of the child care information that is available on the department's website, including, but not limited to, guidance for selecting a child care provider. It requires the department to identify costs associated with providing the printed information and to charge persons requesting the information a fee to cover those costs.
