1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and  
3 allocations are made.

4 **CORRECTIONS, DEPARTMENT OF**

5 **Correctional Center 0162**

6 Initiative: Appropriates one-time funds for the construction of an automotive facility to  
7 allow inmates at the Maine Correctional Center to train on the maintenance of public  
8 safety vehicles. This project must be performed by collaborating with the municipalities  
9 of Gorham and Windham.

16 This bill makes a one-time General Fund appropriation of \$250,000 in fiscal year  
17 2007-08 for the construction of an automotive facility to allow inmates at the Maine  
18 Correctional Center to train on the maintenance of public safety vehicles.
