l	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §11224 is enacted to read:
3	§11224. Hunting big game without a guide
1 5 6	An alien is guilty of hunting big game without a guide if that person hunts big game without being accompanied on the hunt by a person who holds a valid guide license pursuant to chapter 927 authorizing that person to act as a hunting guide.
7	SUMMARY
3	This bill would make it illegal for a person who is not a citizen of the United States to hunt big game without being accompanied by a licensed guide.
