**SUMMARY** 

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This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment clarifies that an additional radiologic procedure recommended by a provider when the results of an initial screening mammogram are not definitive must also be considered a screening mammogram where the bill required an insurance policy to provide coverage for a follow-up mammogram.
