2	Sec. 1. 9-A MRSA §5-118 is enacted to read:
3	§5-118. Attempted collection of debt from minor
4 5 6	Notwithstanding the provisions of section 1-301, subsection 11, a person may not attempt to collect from a minor a debt of any amount incurred in providing health care, health services or medication to the minor. A violation of this section is a Class D crime.
7	SUMMARY
8 9 10	This bill prohibits the collection from a minor of a debt incurred in providing health care, health services or medication to the minor and makes an attempt to collect the debt a Class D crime.
