15 16 17 18	1. Maine model radon standard for new residential construction. "Maine mode radon standard for new residential construction" means the standard published by the American Society for Testing and Materials designated as E-1465-06 Standard Practice for Radon Control Options for the Design and Construction of New Low-Rise Residentia Buildings.
20 21 22 23	2. Standard or code adoption by municipalities. A municipality may not adopt a radon standard or code for new residential construction other than the Maine model rador standard for new residential construction. Nothing in this section requires a municipality to adopt a radon standard or code for new residential construction.
24 25 26 27 28	3. Municipal standards or codes adopted. A radon standard or code for new residential construction adopted by a municipality prior to the effective date of this section is not invalidated by this section, except that if the municipality replaces that standard or code it must adopt the Maine model radon standard for new residential construction.
29 30 31 32	4. References within standard. Codes and standards other than E-1465-06 Standard Practice for Radon Control Options for the Design and Construction of New Low-Rise Residential Buildings that are referenced within the Maine model rador standard for new residential construction are not automatically adopted as part of the Maine model rador standard for new residential construction.

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment requires that if a municipality
adopts a radon standard or code for new residential construction it must adopt the
American Society for Testing and Materials standard E-1465-06. The amendment allows
municipalities that have already adopted radon standards or codes for new residential
construction to keep those standards and codes.
