COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 103, L.D. 111, Bill, "An Act To Designate May 1st of Each Year as Cold War Victory Day"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §151 is enacted to read:

§151. Cold War Victory Day

In recognition of the long and costly struggle of the Cold War and efforts made by the military during the Cold War, which lasted from the end of World War II to the fall of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, the State designates the first day of May as Cold War Victory Day. The Governor shall annually issue a proclamation urging citizens, businesses and organizations to observe the day with appropriate activity to celebrate democracy's victory.'

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the majority report, adds language to recognize the efforts of the military during the Cold War.
