14	Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §150-A is enacted to read:
15	§150-A. Cold War Victory Day
16 17 18 19 20	In recognition of the long and costly struggle of the Cold War, from the end of World War II to the fall of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, the State designates the first day of May as Cold War Victory Day. The Governor shall annually issue a proclamation urging citizens, businesses and organizations to observe the day with appropriate activity to celebrate democracy's victory.'

22 23	This amendment strikes the emergency preamble and emergency clause from the bill. This amendment also corrects the allocation of this provision in order to avoid a conflict with Public Law 2007, chapter 27
