1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 17 MRSA §324-A, sub-§2, ¶C**, as enacted by PL 2003, c. 452, Pt. I, §10
3 and as affected by Pt. X, §2, is amended to read:

4 C. Lucky seven or similar sealed tickets may be sold when that game of chance is
5 licensed by the Chief of the State Police and when a valid license certificate is
6 properly displayed. Notwithstanding the other provisions of this section and section
7 312, lucky seven games may be conducted during the period beginning 2 hours
8 before and ending 2 hours after a "beano" game.

9 Notwithstanding any other rule, lucky seven or other similar sealed tickets may be
10 sold that have a sale value of \$1 or less, and a person who sells lucky seven or similar
11 sealed tickets prior to the conduct of "beano" as a volunteer, as provided in this
12 section, is permitted to play in the "beano" game.

13 **SUMMARY**

14 This bill allows a person who sells lucky seven or other sealed tickets prior to a beano
15 game as a volunteer to play in the beano game. Current Department of Public Safety
16 rules prohibit a person who sells lucky seven or sealed tickets from participating in
17 beano.
