4	This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
5	This bill proposes to reform Maine taxes in the following ways.
6 7	1. The taxable income amount at which the highest income tax rate, currently 8.5%, applies would be increased.
8	2. A local option sales tax would be created.
9	3. The sales tax base would be broadened and stabilized.
