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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 55, L.D. 144, Bill, "An Act To Support
Maine's Free Clinics"

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Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the
summary and inserting the following:

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'Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§16, ¶G-1 is enacted to read:

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G-1. Incorporated nonprofit medical clinics whose sole mission is to provide free
medical care to the indigent or uninsured;

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Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act takes effect October 1, 2007.'

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SUMMARY

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This amendment places the sales tax exemption in a better location in the statutes and
provides an effective date of October 1, 2007.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill will reduce Sales and Use Tax collections by \$2,100 in fiscal year 2007-08 and \$3,120 in fiscal year 2008-09, resulting in a General Fund revenue loss of \$1,991 and \$2,958 respectively.
