#### **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

This bill will reduce Sales and Use Tax collections by \$2,100 in fiscal year 2007-08 and \$3,120 in fiscal year 2008-09, resulting in a General Fund revenue loss of \$1,991 and \$2,958 respectively.
