2	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§90 is enacted to read:
3	90. Free clinics. Sales to an incorporated nonprofit medical clinic whose sole mission is to provide free medical care to the indigent or uninsured.

6 7	This bill excludes from the Maine sales and use tax any free clinic whose sole mission is to provide free medical care to the indigent or uninsured.
