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SUMMARY

2 This amendment replaces the bill and creates a resolve that directs the Commissioner 3 of Public Safety to work in cooperation with the Attorney General to conduct a 4 comprehensive review of other states' concealed weapon laws for the purpose of 5 identifying and seeking other states with whom this State may enter into concealed 6 weapon reciprocity agreements. The Commissioner of Public Safety shall report findings 7 and progress to the Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice and Public Safety no 8 later than January 1, 2008. Upon receipt of the report, the Joint Standing Committee on 9 Criminal Justice and Public Safety may submit necessary implementing legislation to the 10 Second Regular Session of the 123rd Legislature.
