Initiative: Appropriates additional funds on a one-time basis for necessary training pertaining to approved species that can be used for baitfish.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

The Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife will require an additional General Fund appropriation of \$48,000 on a one-time basis in fiscal year 2007-08 for the costs of training wardens and disseminating necessary public information about which species may be used as baitfish.
