1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §10103, sub-§13** is enacted to read:

3 **13. Coding system for fishing regulation.** The commissioner shall adopt a coding
4 system that provides codes for all fishing laws and rules published as an abstract pursuant
5 to subsection 7.

6 **SUMMARY**

7 This bill requires the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to adopt a
8 coding system for the department's annual fishing regulations abstract that assigns codes
9 for all fishing regulations.
