1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and
3 allocations are made.

5 **Office of Child Care and Head Start**

6 Initiative: Provides funding to increase the amount of subsidy for the child care subsidy
7 program to accommodate the increased cost of care since 2002.
