1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 34-A MRSA §11255, sub-§2**, as amended by PL 2003, c. 711, Pt. C, §28  
3 and affected by Pt. D, §2, is further amended to read:

4 **2. Law enforcement agencies.** Upon receipt of the information concerning the  
5 conditional release or discharge of a registrant pursuant to section 11254, subsection 2, a  
6 law enforcement agency shall notify members of a municipality that the law enforcement  
7 agency determines appropriate to ensure public safety.

8 Notice under this subsection must be given to any child care facility licensed under Title  
9 22, chapter 1673 within the municipality.

### SUMMARY

11 This bill requires that a local law enforcement agency notify a licensed child care  
12 facility within a municipality that a sex offender who is conditionally released or  
13 discharged may be domiciled, reside, work or go to college or school in that municipality.
