Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- Sec. 1. 18-A MRSA §3-1201, sub-§(a), ¶(1), as enacted by PL 1979, c. 540, §1, is amended to read:
- 4 (1). The value of the entire estate, wherever located, less liens and encumbrances, does not exceed \$10,000 \$20,000;

This bill increases the amount of personal property of a decedent's estate that can be collected by affidavit from \$10,000 to \$20,000.
