- Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1251, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:
- **3. Issue restrictions.** A person may not receive a license unless:
- 5 A. That person surrenders all valid licenses in that person's possession issued by any jurisdiction; and
- B. The Secretary of State is satisfied that the applicant is a proper person to receive a license; and
- 9 <u>C. That person is a resident. For purposes of this paragraph, "resident" does not include a person described in section 101, subsection 62, paragraph A or B.</u>

11 SUMMARY

This bill requires a person to be a Maine resident in order to receive a Maine driver's license.
