That Driver Has a Point-to-point Permit**

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §501, sub-§10, ¶C**, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2  
3 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:

4 C. The registration permit may not authorize transporting ~~property or~~ passengers.

5 **Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §501, sub-§10-A** is enacted to read:

6 **10-A. Off-highway vehicles; point-to-point permit.** Notwithstanding subsection  
7 10, paragraph D, the Secretary of State may issue, upon application and the payment of a  
8 fee of \$12, a temporary point-to-point permit for a vehicle registered under subsection 10  
9 that allows the vehicle to be used to haul a trailer on a highway from point to point as  
10 specified in the permit.

11 **SUMMARY**

12 This bill allows the Secretary of State to issue a temporary point-to-point permit for  
13 an off-highway vehicle to haul a trailer on a highway from point to point as set forth in  
14 the permit.
