1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRS §555, sub-§4, ¶D** is enacted to read:

3 D. A fine of not more than \$100 may be adjudged for a violation of the requirement
4 for a driver of a commercial motor vehicle to keep a record of duty status for each 24-
5 hour period of driving as required in 49 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 395 or
6 successor regulation.

SUMMARY

8 This bill limits the fine to \$100 for a violation of the federal regulation requiring
