3 §584-B. Traditional uses

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A parcel of land 500 acres or larger that is taxed pursuant to this subchapter must be
open to the public for traditional uses. For purposes of this section, "traditional uses"
includes, but is not limited to, hunting, fishing, trapping, snowmobiling and hiking.
